## **Academic Program**

- Courses are on a block/semester schedule
- Students can dually enroll starting in grade 9
- Students complete grade level projects along with community service hours in grades 9-12
- Approximately half of high school seniors graduate with a 2-year college degree
- Dually enrolled students work with 2 college liaisons who assist students with course and college planning
- Seniors with at least 30 community college hours have the option to stay a 5<sup>th</sup> year to complete an associate degree
